# 3. What the Filling of the Holy Spirit Looks Like (Eph. 5:19-21)

### 4. How Counselors (and Counselees) are Filled with the Holy Spirit (Col. 3:16-17)

### 5. Implications for the Counseling Process

- Counselors need to be filled by the Spirit's Word in the same way counselees are filled:
  - $\checkmark$  Read the Word (1 Tim. 4:13)
  - ✓ Consider the Word (2 Tim. 2:7)
  - $\checkmark$  Search the Word (Acts 17:11)
  - $\checkmark$  Study the Word (2 Tim. 2:15)
  - ✓ Meditate on the Word (Ps. 1:2; Josh. 1:8)
  - ✓ Memorize the Word (Ps. 119:11)
  - ✓ Listen to the Word from other teachers (Phil. 4:9; 1 Cor. 12:28-29; Gal. 6:6)
- Make specific homework assignments from Scripture (for yourself):
  - ✓ Scripture \_\_\_\_\_
