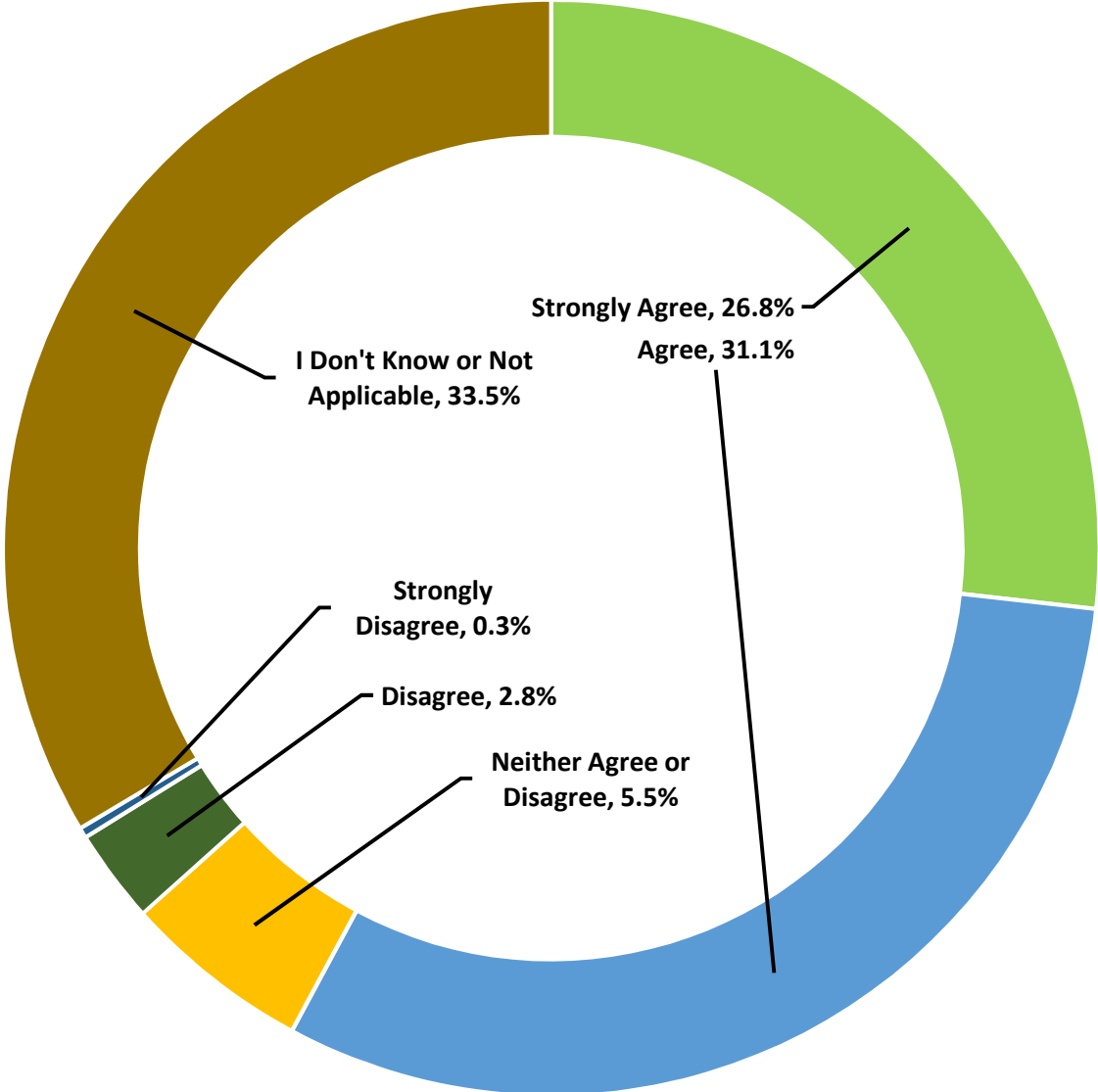


(3) Our nursery puts parents at ease and allows them to easily leave their children in order to attend worship service.
