Student Leadership Team

The Student Leadership Team is an opportunity for young people to get involved in the work of the ministry. The team looks for people who are faithful, available, responsive, and teachable and have a desire to lead.

I. Goals

- 1. Equip young people to ministry to others, especially their peers.
- 2. Regularly meet together to assess each persons ministry.
- 3. To go deeper than the larger youth group in serving and in digging into God's word.
- 4. To mutually encourage growth and discipleship
- 5. To help to connect new and fringe students into the ministry.

II. Responsibilities

- 1. Attend team meetings.
- 2. Serve in one ministry per semester.
- 3. To be active in evangelism when the opportunity comes.
- 4. Help with events, retreats and outreach opportunities.
- 5. Take a leadership role in connecting new and fringe kids into the ministry.
- 6. Take a leadership role in helping to disciple new believers.
- 7. Be a good example. Model servant leadership.

III. Expectations

- 1. Each Student Leader must be willing to go outside their comfort zone and hang out with a new or fringe student all youth group night to help get them plugged into the ministry.
- 2. Each Student Leader should look to Disciple another student after completing the first 2 Discipleship books themselves.
- 3. Each Student Leader is expected to serve in on ministry each semester.
- 4. Every Student Leader is expected to attend all meetings and the retreat that is held each year.
